Post Operative Patient information

Ankle Arthroscopy and Reconstruction (Hamstring Graft)

Pre-operatively - You will have had your Walker Boot measured and fitted

before surgery by SSS (Skeletal Support Systems).

You will need to bring your Walker Boot into hospital to be

fitted after surgery.

Post-operatively - You will need to wear your Walker Boot after surgery

You will need to mobilise with crutches for the first 6 weeks

You may weight-bear as tolerated, progress from partial to full

You may remove the boot when sitting or resting in bed, however you **MUST NOT MOBILISE WITHOUT THE BOOT**

10-14 days post-op-Appointment at Dr Hazratwala's private rooms

Wound will be reviewed and sutures removed

6 weeks post-op – Post-operative appointment at Dr Hazratwala's private rooms

Physiotherapy will commence

Commence use of normal shoes

Application of a sports ankle brace

Increase activities as tolerated

You are advised not to drive a vehicle while in a boot.
